A Brief History of Bethel

November 6, 1965

Beginnings

Bethel began as a mission work in Janesville through the Great Lakes Baptist Conference of the Baptist General Conference (now Converge) with the Articles of Incorporation signed on November 6, 1965.

Buildings

The new church plant initially gathered in the home of the church-planting pastor before moving to a rented dining room at the Monterey Hotel.

As the congregation grew, they acquired 6 acres of land at the current location. The first building constructed was the parsonage, which also served as the sanctuary.

Construction on the current building began in 1976, and in 2001, it was expanded.
This expansion included the addition of a new sanctuary, transforming the original sanctuary into a multi-purpose Family Life Center with a commercial kitchen.



Services

As Bethel began in the 1960's, the service was traditional in nature. In 1994, a contemporary worship service was introduced, with a second service added as growth occurred.

By 2010, an acoustic-style contemporary service ran simultaneously in the Family Life Center featuring a live worship band and a live-streamed service.

In October 2016, a second acoustic service was introduced, bringing the total number of Sunday morning services to five across three service times. In 2018, the traditional and acoustic services were replaced by two predominantly contemporary services, with the Family Life Center used for overflow.

However, in 2022, an acoustic service was reintroduced, bringing the current total to three services during two service times. Communion is celebrated monthly, with weekly attendance around 300.

Pastoral Staff

In its 60 year history, Bethel has been guided by 8 senior pastors and several associate pastors specializing in areas such as worship, youth, children's & family ministries, outreach or visitation, along with an executive pastor. Some positions have been held on a part-time basis.

We currently have an Executive Pastor and a Pastor of Youth/Outreach and Worship. A search committee representing various ministries of the church is working to find the next senior pastor for Bethel.
