WORSHIP LEADER JOB DESCRIPTION

The Worship Leader is a part-time position tasked with planning, preparing for, and leading our weekly worship service that connects with both younger and older generations, promotes authentic worship, and proclaims the message of the Gospel. There must be a desire to live in a rural, tight-knit community.

Qualifications:

- Clear testimony of a life that has trusted in and is walking with Jesus Christ
- Experience planning, preparing, and leading multi-generational worship services
- A heart to lead people in worship and not just lead a worship service
- Agrees with our church's beliefs and doctrines according to our church constitution

Abilities:

- Skilled in vocal and instrumental direction and can read music skillfully
- Can proficiently play an instrument in the worship band (ex. guitar, keyboard)
- Quality singing voice and engaging stage presence
- Has experience using technology in worship, such as lighting, worship software, sound systems, video production, etc.
- An awareness of and willingness to learn website software to keep church events and information current.
- Team player with good relational skills and a positive attitude

Responsibilities:

- Lead the congregation in worship and direct the flow and elements of the service.
- Has a discipleship heart and mentality of raising up others to participate in worship, both youth and active adult attendees within the church.
- Develop a weekly order of service in coordination with the pastor and communicate it in advance to the worship and A/V team members.
- Able to work with and understand video production and editing. The worship services are expected to be posted and edited (if necessary).
- The worship leader will oversee and/or assist the church's website, keeping information current and up to date.
- Direct a weekly rehearsal with the worship team that prepares for a quality performance on Sunday and can develop and introduce new music to the congregation in upcoming services. The worship leader will collaborate with the lead pastor in selecting music; however, it is also essential the worship leader is open to input from the other members of the worship team in song choices.
- Ensure that the stage set-ups, lighting, sound system, video systems, and worship presentation software are working correctly and ready for the service.
- Oversee the design/decoration of the stage to keep it fresh, orderly, and connecting with the current season or emphasis of the church.
- Recruit and/or develop new musicians, singers, and A/V team members sufficient to carry out the weekly needs of the service and prepare for future needs.
- Develop a yearly budget for the modern service and follow the financial guidelines for purchases.
- Work under the guidance of the lead pastor.

Compensation:

This is a part-time position, paid bi-monthly. Salary is to be determined based on experience and expected time committed to the position. Expect between 20-30 hours per week. There may be additional opportunities to make the position full-time.
